1. In-kind contributions to date, for the two DEP grants are:

BMP3: \$38,296.00

Quittie Park: Amount consultants have incurred but not bill and will not bill

(overruns): \$55,762

2. 319 Application –The EPA has reviewed the 319 grant application and they want a few additional items. Brett Long made a few suggestions for proposed projects to be included in the WIP.

3. The Quittie Park Grant has been extended to June 30, 2013.

Rocky Powell has coordinated with the Fish and Boat Commission and they have completed the stream survey that will be part of the grant match. A \$5500 check was sent by Trout Unlimited to the Lebanon Valley Conservancy to fund additional work items including preliminary archaeology survey coordination. The Conservancy voted that they would

manage these funds from Trout Unlimited to allow the permitting process to move forward.

4. BMP3 Grant – The grant has been extended to March 4, 2013

5. QCWA File Cabinets - we now have two large file cabinets for the QCWA at the Annville Train Station. Any information related to the organization can be stored in these file cabinets. There is already records stored in the file cabinets.
