- 1. The minutes of the October 17, 2013 were approved as revised.
- 2. Kent Crawford reported upon his participation in an open house event held at the Dauphin County Conservation District.
- 3. Mike Schroeder agreed to contact Annville Township regarding the dumping of potentially hazardous materials into an inlet that eventually discharges Stormwater runoff into the Quittie.
- 4. Kent Crawford discussed a possible temperature / dissolved oxygen study that could explain the inability for the lower reach of the Quittie to sustain a trout population. He suggested that the study could be performed by a college student and that the project could be funded by a grant. He estimated that the cost /grant would be in the range of \$20,000. Kent agreed to have more details available for the next meeting.
- 5. It was agreed that the meetings for January through April would be held on the third Thursday of each month.
- 6. David Lasky discussed having members of the QWA attend a meeting with the Lebanon Valley Conservancy. Members of the Conservancy want to review the grant application of the Association for Phase 1 of the streambank restoration project.
- 7. Each member who would be attending the meeting with the Conservancy was requested to send a brief resume to Mike Schroeder.
