

**QUITTAPAHILLA WATERSHED ASSOCIATION
MEETING MINUTES
ANNVILLE TOWN HALL
May 22, 2014**

Present: David Lasky, Ann Lasky, Mike Schroeder, Kent Crawford, Karen Feather

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM

1. Dave Lasky offered an update on the Growing Greener grant, including synopses of discussions with Pennsy Supply on pending donations of rocks for the project; with Jineen Boyle of PA-DEP, who has sent the grant to the legal department for review; and with Diana Day of the PA Fish & Boat Commission.
2. Dave Lasky reported that he had received some 300 sapling trees from the PA Game Commission for use in the Growing Greener project that are now potted in Dave's backyard.
3. Dave Lasky reported that the next round of Growing Greener is scheduled for late August, and encouraged the Association to be in touch with Rocky Powell to suggest that he think about watershed priorities and the contents of our next grant application.
4. Kent asked that Mike send him LVC Chemistry Professor Owen Moe's email address (moe@lvc.edu) so that they can be in touch regarding Prof. Moe's summer research project with students that will test the Quittie's waters for dissolved oxygen, pH, turbidity, and other measures. Suggestions were made that the waters be tested at the mouth of Snitz Creek; at the Pennsy Supply discharge point on Killinger Creek; at the Anville Wastewater Treatment Plant; and at the South Londonderry Wastewater Treatment Plant.
5. Mike reported that he continues to await the review of the Association's revised Watershed Implementation Plan (WIP) by Scott Heidel at PA-DEP.
6. Kent suggested that the Association pursue additional grant opportunities, including the Chesapeake Bay Foundation and perhaps the League of Women Voters.

Meeting adjourned at 8:00 PM.
