MEETING MINUTES

September 18, 2014**

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM

1. David Lasky will contact Harry Campbell of the Chesapeake Bay Foundation regarding the riparian buffer currently in effect within the state. The purpose of the contact will be to determine if the rules can be relaxed to get more farmers interested in allowing buffer planting. The Association had previously worked with a number of farmers in the watershed to get permission to plan and fence stream banks. Since the wider requirements have been in effect no additional planting has occurred.
2. David Lasky reported that funding agreement with the Fish and Boat Commission had been signed.
3. Mike Schroeder agreed to work with Rocky Powell to set up a meeting with DEP to discuss the WIP and receive guidance for its completion.
4. At a date to be determined, Katie McCardle, a student at LVC will present the results of testing along the Quittie.
5. It was decided to continue to work with the Lebanon Valley Conservancy as well as investigate the feasibility of organizing the Association as a 501(c) 3 non-profit.
