

**QUITTAPAHILLA WATERSHED ASSOCIATION
MEETING MINUTES
ANNVILLE TOWN HALL
May 21, 2015**

Present: Mike Schroeder, Dave Lasky, Alan Wood, Karen Feather, Kent Crawford, David Bailey

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM

1. Dave Lasky led a discussion of tree planting in the restored part of the Nature Park. A provisional date of the first week of June was discussed, as was the interest of Ms. Paulette Thompson and her family, including her son who is a Boy Scout, in volunteering to help. Dave L. agreed to be in touch and schedule the volunteer workday.
2. Dave L. reported that Carl Lutz of Fish & Boat suggested that for accounting purposes, \$2,000 of the \$80,000 contributed by the Fish & Boat Commission for Phase 1 of the Streambank Restoration Project be extended to 2016.
3. Dave L. reported on anticipating Phase 2 of the project; that Ned Gibble of the LVConservancy has his paperwork in with DEP and Fish & Boat; and that a pre-construction conference will be held among all involved parties, the date to be determined.
4. Volunteers: Kent indicated he will solicit assistance among the members of the Doc Fritchey Chapter of Trout Unlimited; that he will serve as Volunteer Coordinator and the Keeper of the Volunteer List.
5. It was determined that equipment needed for the planting will include shovels, wheelbarrows, pickaxes, and buckets.
6. Meeting with Rocky Powell: Possible dates were discussed for a future meeting with Rocky Powell to discuss where the Association goes from here with respect to projects, our WIP, long-term and short-term goals and objectives.
7. Discussion was held regarding the keen interest of Cleona Borough Manager Kerry Rohland in a streambank stabilization project similar to the one underway in Quittie Park.
8. Karen Feather suggested that Rocky Powell might consider teaching a class at LVC in grant-writing.
9. Upcoming events: Dave L. reported that a meeting with State Rep. Russ Diamond will be held in the Nature Park at 9 AM, Thursday June 11. The QWA presence at Historic Old Anville Day was discussed, as was the possibility of updating our trifold brochure.

The meeting adjourned at 8:00 PM.
